

## Which Photos/Videos Should You Use for your Tribute Video?

Selecting a specific number of photos that represent someone's full life can be challenging.

To help in your selection process, use the Tips and List as a guide.

### Tips

- Use photos that include the individual alone or with close family and friends.
- Select photos with (warm, fun, memorable) stories behind each so to elicit a positive or heartwarming reaction.
- Include special documents in your loved one's life.
- Arrange your photos in Chronological Order

*Here is a chronological list of suggested topics with the number of photos to use for each time period. Of course, every person has his/her unique Life Story, so adjust accordingly.*

### List

Photo Suggestions (Typically always include your loved one in the photo)

# of Photos   Description

3-5..... Early Years – growing up, parents, siblings, activities as a child

3-6..... High School – sports, friends, activities, graduation

2-3..... Military Career (if applicable) discharge papers, awards,

5-8..... Marriage – dating, wedding, honeymoon, places, friends, events, pre-kids

5-8..... Children/Family – birth, child, family photo, siblings

8-10..... Family Activities – holidays, vacations, gatherings, hobbies, places

3-5..... Other family members/friends

2-4..... Career/Job – early years, noteworthy events or achievements, awards

8-10..... Retirement Years – family, significant events, kids, grandkids, travel, hobbies

*Scenic photos such as a special summer home, vacation spot, sports team, etc. may also be considered.*
